Parenting in Real Time

Child and Family Services offers the “Always a Parent” program to parents who are having difficulty communicating with a co-parent. This program is recommended for parents who share a child and are divorced, separated, married, or never been married. “Always a Parent” emphasizes the impact of parents’ behavior on their children, and teaches parents positive, effective, cooperative communication techniques.

Parenting 101

Be a role model. Your children will learn far more from how you act than what you say.

Ask your kids questions. This lets them know you value their opinions.

Control your anger. Take a few deep breaths, try to relax, and then let them know why you are angry.
Works with adults as well as kids!

Spend time with your kids. Even TV can be quality time if you snuggle with them and talk about what you are watching. Play together. Read them a bedtime story.

When things go wrong, don't call children names or use sarcasm. Focus on the behavior that is unacceptable, not the child.

What You Can Expect From the Always a Parent Program

- Classes start the first Monday of the month and run four consecutive weeks
- All classes are held at Child and Family Services, Traverse City
- \$80 fee includes sessions and textbook
- Certificate issued upon successful course completion
